APPRECIATIVE COACHING

The Clergy Leadership Institute's Appreciative Coaching and Training is based on the **Appreciative Wa**y, Rob and Kim Voyle's synthesis of:

- The practice and philosophy of Appreciative Inquiry
- The work of Milton Erickson and his students
- Compassion as the agent of transformation

This synthesis results in a model of coaching that is:

Incarnational

We join Clients in their world and journey with them to their future, rather than drag them into the Coach's world.

Compassionate

We use the three archetypal energies of compassion: tenderness, fierceness, and playfulness, to care for, challenge, and liberate Clients into their future.

Future Oriented

We help clients establish positive goals and discover the resources they need to create their preferred future.

Lived in the Present

While future oriented the path to the future is found by living fully in this present moment.

Informed by the Past

A Client's history is a treasure trove of resources that they can use to positively inform their present and inspire their future.

Solution Focused

We seek solutions to problems rather than focus on causes and blame for past failures an problems.

Values Based

We help Client's discover and integrate their personal values into how they live and work so they can live with integrity.

Purpose Centered

We believe people were created for a purpose and have all the resources they need to fulfill their purpose.

Love Inspired

We believe that at the heart of the universe is a Heart of Love that embraces both Coach and Client and accepts both, gracefully without condition. This heart of love is the Source of our existence and the essence of our life. Growing in living and liberally sharing that love with ourselves and others is the fruit of Appreciative Coaching.
